How to Import a Search File into Telus PS

1. Download the searches from AFHTO website onto your desktop
2. In PS select RECORDS
3. Go to SETTINGS
4. Select EDIT SEARCHES
5. Click EDIT, then on the pull down menu select IMPORT SEARCH(S)
6. Locate the search files on your desktop that you would like to import (there are 2 different files to import)
7. Make sure it is an .srx file
8. Click it, then press CHOOSE
