## ► What is the MSc eHealth Program?

Built on the strength of McMaster University's experiential learning platform, the MSc eHealth degree is truly interdisciplinary. The program is based on a partnership among the Faculties of Health Sciences (Clinical Epidemiology and Biostatistics Department), Engineering (Computing and Software Department) and Business (Information Systems area in the DeGroot School of Business).

## ► What is the eHealth Internship Program?

The MSc eHealth Internship Program combines three or four academic terms with an eight month internship commencing in May and ending in December. eHealth students are ideally suited for special project assignments, and can also handle ongoing operational responsibilities as needed.

## ► What do MSc eHealth Students Learn before their Internship?

During their first two academic terms, students learn:


- How to navigate the Canadian healthcare system and the role eHealth tools can play
- Challenges and emerging technology demands in the growing network of healthcare systems
- Risk analysis and project management skills in team-based situations
- Leading research and evaluation methods specific to eHealth
